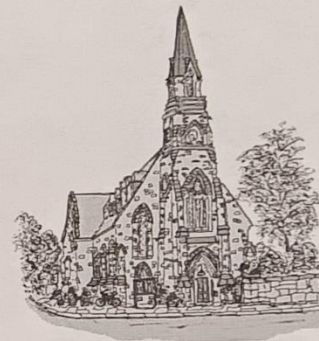
### IMPORTANT NOTICE
