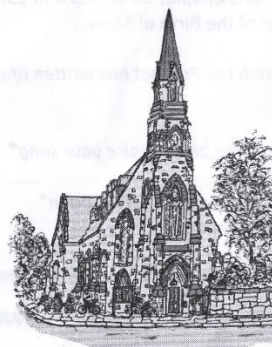
IMPORTANT NOTICE
