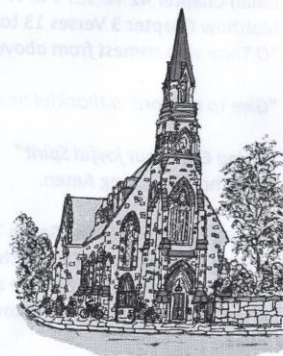
IMPORTANT NOTICE
