

St George's URC Morpeth -Worship Guidelines for August

These may be amended from time to time as further advice or guidelines are given from the Government or the Synod Moderators.

We are looking forward to worshipping together with our friends from Morpeth Methodist Church in our joint services this summer.

In order to keep each other safe we suggest the following guidelines.

- 1** We must maintain a safe environment for both Ministers and Congregation. We therefore recommend continuing social distancing in open areas and encourage the wearing of face masks within the building.
- 2** We encourage everyone to continue to use hand sanitizer when entering the building.
- 3** We will continue to maintain a careful cleaning routine within church by wiping down contact points such as door handles, switches etc.
- 4** When singing hymns in church please do so wearing a facemask in consideration of those around you.
- 5** All seating rows will be open and you are welcome to sit together in the seating in the centre of church and on the Bridge Street side.
- 6** For those who wish to continue social distancing we will have a designated area which will be in the South Transept and on the river side.
- 7** There will be no coffee served after the services in August.
