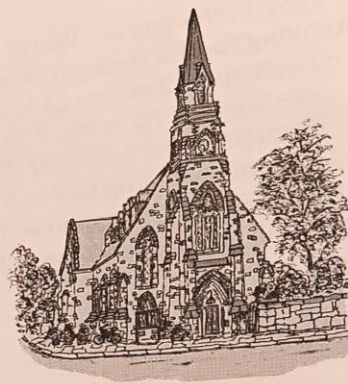
IMPORTANT NOTICE
