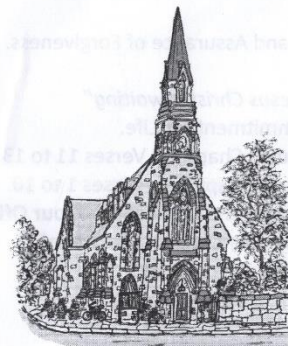
IMPORTANT NOTICE
